It is again directed to implement the instructions dated 29.08.2012 and 19.02.2013 in letter and spirit for strict compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 02.02.011 passed by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh in CWP No. 11686 of 2004 titled as Haryana State Adhyapak Sangh (Government Aided Private Schools) Versus State of Haryana and Others as the said writ petition was allowed by the Hon'ble High Court in terms of the decision dated 10.11.2010 passed in CWP No. 6220 of 2009 titled as Haryana Private Colleges Non-Teaching Employees Union (Regd.) Versus State of Haryana.

It is made clear that in case of failure you will be held solely responsible for disobedience of the aforesaid orders of the Hon'ble High Court and strict action will be initiated against the concerned erring managements as per sections/provisions of Haryana School Education Act, 1995 and Haryana School Education Rules, 2003.

1. In pursuance of the order dated (2.02.2011) passed by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh in CWP No. 11586 of 2004 titled as Haryana State Adhyapak Sangh (Govt. Aided Private Schools) versus State of Haryana and others, the State Government has decided to allow Assured Career Progression to the teaching & non-teaching employees of Privately Managed Govt. Aided Schools in the State of Haryana in terms of Notification No.G.S.R.4/Const./Art.309/98 dated 07.01.1998 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 titled as Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 1998 of the State Government as conveyed vide Memo No. 1/5-2012 AS(1) dated 29.08.2012 subject to outcome of the Review Petition No. D8247 of 2012 filed by the Higher Education Department Haryana, Panchkula against the order dated 19.09.2011 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (civil) No. 24467 of 2011.
