

Notice issued by Department of School Education Haryana is enclosed herewith. It is hereby directed to comply with the directions regarding acquisition of requisite minimum professional qualifications for teachers under RTE Act, 2009.

In this context, you are requested to issue instructions to all the Principals/Heads/Incharges of Govt./Govt.Aided/Unaided Private Schools in Haryana. A certificate of compliance from concerned Principal/Head of school is required to be submitted upto 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 positively from the publishing of this advertisement otherwise it will be presumed that all the teachers serving in respective schools possess the minimum professional qualification as per RTE Act-2009 and concerned Principal/Head will be held responsible for any misinformation. 

Attention of all in-service untrained elementary teachers, working in the Govt./Govt. Aided/Unaided-Private Schools of Haryana, is drawn towards recent circular dated 03.08.2017 of Department of School Education & Literacy, MHRD, GOI, New Delhi. **It is apprised that the Amendment to the Section 23(2) of the RTE Act to extend the period for such training to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2019 has been passed by the Parliament.**

**Further, it is reiterated that this will be last chance to acquire the requisite minimum professional qualifications. Any teacher in the aforementioned schools, who does not have the minimum qualifications (D.El.Ed or equivalent) mandated under the RTE Act 2009 would not be allowed to continue in-service beyond 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2019 and procedure for dismissal/removal shall be initiated against such teachers.**

In the light of above, all the Principals/Heads/In charges of Govt./Govt. Aided/Unaided-Private Schools in Haryana are hereby directed to comply with the directions regarding acquisition of requisite minimum professional qualifications for teachers under RTE Act, 2009. A certificate of compliance from concerned Principal/Head of school is required to be submitted upto 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 from the publishing of this advertisement otherwise it will be presumed that all the teachers serving in respective schools possess the minimum professional qualification as per RTE Act-2009 and concerned Principal/Head will be held responsible for any misinformation.
