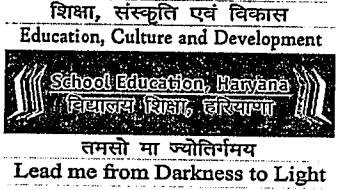

**SUBJECT: STATE AWARD TO TEACHERS FOR THE YEAR 2017 AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS THEREOF.**

Reference on the subject cited above.

You are aware that State Awards are awarded by the Government to teachers every year on 5<sup>th</sup> September. Accordingly nominations for the State Award to the teachers -2017 are invited.

You are therefore, requested to send the recommendations for the State Award-2017 on the basis of criteria enclosed.

District committees shall apply the criteria (enclosed) and in no case they shall recommend names of teachers unless the score of an individual is 50% or more.

While recommending the cases for the State Award the following points may be taken into consideration:-

**A. Categories of Award – Elementary & Secondary:-**

The following categories of teachers shall be eligible for nominations:-

- i) Category A (Elementary) - PRT, Head Teacher, C&V, TGT and ESHM.

- ii) Category B (Secondary) - PGTs, Head Master High School and Principal).

**B. Eligibility Conditions:-**

- i) Classroom teachers with at least 15 years of regular teaching experience. Headmasters/Principals with 20 years of regular teaching experience out of which at least 5 years service, as Headmaster/Principal including Current Duty Charge (CDC).
- ii) For teachers promoting Integrated Inclusive Education, the regular teaching experience shall be reduced from 15 years to 10 years of regular service. In case of Headmasters/ Principals, 15 years teaching experience including 5 years service, as Headmaster/ Principal.
- iii) The State Award are meant for teachers. Thus, non teachers like DEOs/ DEEOs/Principal DIETs/Dy. DEOs/BEOs/BEOs need not apply.
- iv) The qualifying date for determining the eligibility and merit of the teachers be considered for the award, shall be 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year for which awards are to be given. For example, if awards are to be conferred in the year 2017, then the qualifying date shall be 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017.
- v) All cases should be routed through proper channel so that the forwarding/recommending authority could have an opportunity to make a proper and detailed assessment of the case.
- vi) Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs) for the last ten years shall be considered. For being eligible for consideration for the award, a teacher must have 'Plus A' (+A) grading in ACRs for 5 years out of the last 10 years. No teacher below 'A' grading in any year shall be considered for the award.
- vii) In case of teachers teaching Board classes, the Board Class results (of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Classes) must have been above the State average of the result for the last 5 years.
- viii) In case of Head of Institution (Principal/Headmaster), the general school results of Board classes (10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) must have been above the State average of the result for the last 5 years.

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- ix) In case of teachers teaching Non-Board classes, the Non-Board Class results must have been 80% or above for the last 5 years.

**C. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:-**

The names of the teachers shall be recommended firstly by the Block Education Officers concerned to the District Level Committee on the basis of the Teacher's Service record.

Thereafter, the District Level Committee shall recommend the names to the State Level Committee which will finally recommend the names of teachers to the State Government.

The District and State Level Committee shall consist as follows:-

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The State Level Committee shall examine all recommendation of the District Level Committees and may call for additional information (including production of record) if required. The State Level Committee shall also conduct a formal class-room teaching evaluation of the short listed teachers. The committee may even ask SCERT Gurgaon to conduct a learning level evaluation of the children being taught by the short listed teachers.

#### **D. Main Considerations for Awards**

The scheme envisages that those teachers who show exceptional academic efficiency, quality of teaching and professional competence, good conduct & team spirit, engagement with the local community, utilize innovative teaching methods and command respect in the community are to be recommended for the awards. Main considerations are:

##### **(I) Academic Efficiency:**

- a. Results
- b. Teacher Products
- c. Teaching Innovations

##### **(II) Personal Achievements:**

- a. Good ACR's
- b. Acquiring Higher academic qualifications
- c. Personal Conduct
- d. Team Spirit/Discipline
- e. Duties performed in addition to teaching
- f. Trainings attended.

##### **(III) Involvement in Social Life of Community**

##### **(IV) Academic and Co-Curricular achievements of the Children**


The summary sheets of last ten years of ACRs alongwith photocopy of the ACRs of the recommended teachers are to be sent. The board results/school results of the teachers and other necessary documents/ certificates (duly counter-signed and attested by the District Committee) should also be sent.

Needless to say each recommendation shall be scrutinized in detail by the District Level Selection Committee and if required the data upon which the recommendations are based

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(e.g. lesson plans, teacher diaries, children diaries, CCE records, project based learning records, etc) can be called to Head Office for verification.

The recommendations of the District Level Committee should reach the Directorate upto 31.07.2017 positively through special messenger.
