Whereas, being highly populated areas, the availability of land for opening/upgradation of new schools in the cities of Faridabad, Gurugram and Panchkula is usually scarce.

And whereas the same high population has corresponding high demand for opening of new schools for spread of education in the society.

And whereas the School Education Department, Haryana has at present the ceiling of norms for land for the private Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools of two acre for both categories.



And whereas the ceiling of two acre has un-reasonably restricted the supply of schools in these areas.

And whereas land norms are being applied by multiple authorities and sometimes conflicting situations arise on the issue of norms to be applied to a new request for opening/up-gradation of a school. In such situations, it has been very difficult to decide as to which authority's decision shall prevail in regard to land norms for opening/up-gradation of a school.

And whereas the aggregate of restrictions and conflicts as discussed above has been causing complication/hardships to the new initiatives in the field of school education.

Therefore, the Govt. has decided that for opening/up-gradation of private Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools in the cities of Faridabad, Gurugram and Panchkula, the land norms be relaxed to **one acre** and the decision of the School Education Department shall prevail in the event of any conflict on this issue with any other institution/department.

This issues with the prior approval of the competent authority.
