
Sh. Inder Jeet Singh, the then Head Master, GHS Agon (Mewat) now posted as Principal, GSSS, Agon (Mewat) was charge sheeted under Rule-8 of Haryana Punishment & Appeals Rules, 1987 vide order No. 5/49-2007 HRG-I (1) Dated, 16.04.2007, wherein following charges were leveled against him:-

“यह कि उसके कार्यकाल में मिडल परीक्षा फरवरी 2007 में 52 बच्चे परीक्षा में बैठे जिसमें से केवल 5 बच्चे ही उत्तीर्ण हुए। जिससे स्कूल का वार्षिक परीक्षा परिणाम केवल 9.61% ही रहा। उक्त शिक्षण सत्र का परीक्षा परिणाम उसकी कार्य प्रणाली एवं ड्यूटी के प्रति कोताही तथा विद्यालय के स्टाफ पर नियन्त्रण न होना दर्शाता है तथा आम जनता की नजरों में विभाग की छवि धूमिल हुई है।”

He submitted his reply to the charge sheet on 07.01.2013 and contended that during the academic session 2006-07 one post of Hindi teacher, two post of Science Master and three post of Mathematics Master were lying vacant in this school. Guest Teachers who were engaged against this vacant post on a late stage of the academic session also left the job in the mid of the session. Block Education Officer, Firozpur Zirka has given his comments that pass percentage of board of Middle Classes Examination in February, 2007 was 10 percentage whereas school result was 10.41 percentage which is more then board result. It has been happed due to vacant post of Teachers.

From the face of the record. put up before the undersigned, reply to the chargesheet made by Sh. Inder Jeet Singh, show that there is no intentional lapse on part of the delinquent and his explanation seems to be satisfactory, hence, charge sheet issued to him vide order No. 5/49-2007 HRG-I (1) dated 16.04.2007 is dropped, however, he is advised to improve the results in future.
