Saroorpur, Ballabgarh, Faridabad**, for classes from **9 to 12** in subjects of **Arts, Commerce & Science** under **BOSE** pattern with effect from 01.04.2015 under the following terms and conditions:-

TERMS & CONDITIONS:-

1. This permanent Recognition is granted that on the subject to the condition that the documents/information furnished by the school authorities are factual and not devoid of truth in any way, however, if any information at any stage, is found contrary to the facts the recognition would be revoked forthwith.
2. The school shall follow the course of study as per syllabus prescribed by the affiliated board.
3. The school shall charge fees and funds as declared to the appropriate authority at the time of application for recognition and display the same on the notice board of the school and shall not increase the fees during the any academic session. In case of any change in the fee structure the school shall inform to the appropriate authority in the month of January for the next academic year and will also issue printed receipts of fees/funds to the students.
4. Salary shall be paid as per declaration at the time of seeking recognition.
5. No capitation fee and other charges shall be charged from the children/parents.
6. School shall be open for admission without any discrimination based on religion, caste, race, place of birth or any other whimsical.
7. Managing Committee shall not allow to run two schools affiliated by different board/council in the same premises.
8. Managing Committee shall not close down the school or any existing class during the academic session without the prior approval of the appropriate authority.
9. The school shall be open for inspection for the inspecting officer authorized by the Director/Appropriate Authority.
10. Recognition so granted shall be reviewed after every 10 years.
11. No financial assistance shall be granted by the Department to the school.
12. School premises shall not be used for commercial purpose and anti National activities.
13. Approval of Managing Committee shall be obtained from the appropriate authority in case of any change in the committee.
14. The Managing Committee shall follow the instructions issued by Government/Director from time to time and supply the information to the Govt./Department as required.
15. In addition to above the Managing Committee shall abide by the provisions of Haryana School Education Rules, 2003 and amendments if any thereafter. The Managing Committee shall be liable for disciplinary action in case of violation of any provisions of the rules.
16. School will provide ramp within six months otherwise recognition will stand withdrawn.
17. If any information, at any stage found Contrary to the Fact's the recognition would be revoked forthwith.
18. That the number of students in classroom shall not be more than the students calculated on the 10 square feet per student for secondary and Senior Secondary Schools and 9 Square feet per student for elementary state.
19. The managing committee shall abide by the provisions of Haryana School Education Rules 2003(amended) & R.T.E. Rules 2011 and amendments if any thereafter. The Managing shall be liable for disciplinary action in case of violation of any provision of the rules.

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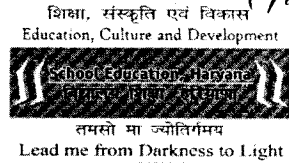

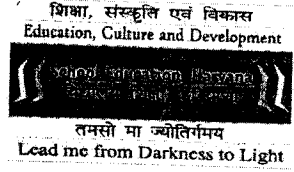

ORDER No. 13/59-2015 HRL-I (4) DATED, PANCHKULA, THE - 02/11/15

Whereas Sh. Krishan Kumar and others had filed CWP No. 5735 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein for directing the respondent No. 1 and 2 to issue appointments to the petitioners as PGT Sociology and grant all consequential benefits from the date, respondents started violating their rights etc. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Court on 27.03.2015 with the following directions:-

"The present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No. 2- Director, Secondary Education, Shikshay Sadan, Panchkula, to decide the legal notice dated 24.10.2014 (Annexure P-14) and take appropriate decision, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the claim of the petitioners is accepted, then consequential benefits, if any, be given to the petitioners, within a further period of two months. In case, respondent do not grant any relief then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly."

The brief facts of the case are that the Haryana School Teacher's Selection Board advertised the posts in different subjects of PGT on 07.06.2012 and the name of the petitioners Sh. Krishan Kumar S/o Sh. Dhooop Singh, Sh. Rajbir Singh S/o Sh. Hardeva and Sh. Satyawan S/o Sh. Zile Singh were recommended for appointment as Post Graduate Teacher in Sociology, vide Merit No. 87, 70 and 81 respectively by the Haryana School Teachers

Selection Board, Panchkula vide letter No. 2/1/2013-HSTSB/2013/CA dated 20.03.2013. While recommending the names of selected candidates the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula had made the following observation:-

"The selected candidate has not been medically examined and no special enquiry into his/her antecedents has been made. The documents pertaining to his/her qualifications, 4 Year Experience, age, caste/category and Universities as claimed by him/her in the application form may please be got checked/ verified from the issuing authorities, before he/she is allowed to join her duty. A

copy of the appointment letter issued to the candidate may also be endorsed to the Board."

In view of the above observation of the Haryana Teacher Selection Board, different committees to verify the experience certificate and other documents of the selected candidates were constituted. During verification of experience certificate of the petitioners (i.e. Sh. Krishan Kumar and Sh. Satyawan), the committee found that the Cambridge Public School, Khidrabad Road, Assandh (Karnal) failed to produce any record relating to the experience certificate issued by the school. Moreover, no student's strength appeared in 10+2 exam in different years available from BOSE full. Thus, Committee observed that the experience, which was the base of the selection of the petitioners was not in order.

It is pertinent to mention here that a special relaxation was provided under Rule 7 of Haryana State Education School Cadre, Group B, Service Rule 2012 in HTET to those candidates who have worked as a teacher for a minimum periods of four years on the date of enforcement of these Rules. The relevant extract of the Rules are given here as under:-

Further, note 1 below Appendix-B says (in case of Direct recruitment the teachers working in Privately managed Govt. Aided, Recognised and Government Schools, are exempted to acquire qualification of passing HTET as described in column 3 if they have worked as a teacher for a minimum period of 4 years on the date of enforcement of these rules. However, the said exemption is as a one-time measure and the said category of teachers on their appointment shall have to qualify HTET by not later than 1st April, 2015 later on the same has been extend upto 1st April, 2018 otherwise their appointment shall stand terminated automatically without giving any further notice.

Consequently a Show Cause Notices vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4) dated 17.07.2014 were served upon the petitioners that why their candidature may not be recommended for cancellation to the appropriate authority in view of the observation of the Committee. The petitioners submitted their replies dated Nil in response to the above said show cause notices. Thereafter an opportunity of personal hearing was given to the petitioners. They appeared before the Additional Chief Secretary Secondary Education on 06.08.2014 and reiterated the same facts, which they had already given in their replies. After due consideration, it has been observed that the experience certificate acquired by the petitioners are not as per the norms prescribed by the department on the basis of student strength. Thereafter, a show cause notice vide memo vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4)

dated 22.10.2014 was also served upon to the school concerned to prove the genuineness of the teaching experience certificate issued to the candidate concerned. The School Management did not submit its reply to the said show cause notice.

The School Management of Cambridge Public School, Khidrabad Road, Assandh (Karnal) had issued teaching experiences to Sh. Krishan Kumari, PGT Sociology, Merit No. 87 and Sh. Satyawan, PGT Sociology, Merit No. 81, but the teaching experience of both of them relate to almost same period. Details of the students appeared from said school in 10+2 examination during the tenure i.e. 10.04.2007 to 12.07.2012 and 02.04.2008 to 12.07.2012 respectively given as under:-

As per norms prescribed by the department each section shall be of 50 students and 2nd section will be allowed after 50 students and 3rd section will be created after 100 students and so on. The PGT will be given a maximum of 6 periods in a day i.e. total of 36 periods per week, 2nd post can be created after work load of 40 periods.

Thus as per the student's strength during the period and on the basis of work load teaching experiences issued by the management to two Lecturers neither genuine nor justifiable.

In view of the position enunciated above, Sh. Krishan Kumar S/o Sh. Dhoop Singh and Sh. Satyawan S/o Sh. Zile Singh, whose names are recommended by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula for the post of PGT Sociology, cannot be appointed. Hence, their name is recommended for cancellation of the candidature.

Krishan Kumar and others had filed CWP No. 5735 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein for directing the respondent No. 1 and 2 to issue appointments to the petitioners as PGT Sociology and grant all consequential benefits from the date, respondents started violating their rights etc. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Court on 27.03.2015 with the following directions:-

"The present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No. 2- Director, Secondary Education, Shikshay Sadan, Panchkula, to decide the legal notice dated 24.10.2014 (Annexure P-14) and take appropriate decision, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the claim of the petitioners is accepted, then consequential benefits, if any, be given to the petitioners, within a further period of two months. In case, respondent do not grant any relief then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly."

2. The brief facts of the case are that the Haryana School Teacher's Selection Board advertised the posts in different subjects of PGT on 07.06.2012 and the name of the petitioner Sh. Krishan Kumar S/o Sh. Dhoop Singh, Sh. Rajbir Singh S/o Sh. Hardeva and Sh. Satyawan S/o Sh. Zile Singh were recommended for appointment as Post Graduate Teacher in Sociology, vide Merit No. 87, 70 and 81 respectively by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula vide letter No. 2/1/2013-HSTSB/2013/CA dated 20.03.2013. While recommending the names of selected candidates the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula had made the following observation:-

"The selected candidate has not been medically examined and no special enquiry into his/her antecedents has been made. The documents pertaining to his/her qualifications, 4 Year Experience, age, caste/category and Universities as claimed by him/her in the application form may please be got checked/ verified from the issuing authorities, before he/she is allowed to join her duty. A

copy of the appointment letter issued to the candidate may also be endorsed to the Board.”

3. In view of the above observation of the Haryana Teacher Selection Board, different committees to verify the experience certificate and other documents of the selected candidates were constituted. During verification of experience certificate of the petitioners (i.e. Sh. Krishan Kumar, Sh. Rajbir Singh and Sh. Satyawan), the committee found that in the record of B.K.B Sr. Sec. School, VPO Chorkarsa (Karnal) that attendance register and A-Roll seems prepared afresh. No designation and sign of Principal on attendance Register, only nine Lecturers, no TGT/PRT/Class-IV is shown in the register. No signature of Principal on A-Roll and it is reported that there is no Principal in the school. Committee is of the opinion that the experience is not genuine. Being fresh prepared may be send to Forensic Lab for testing. Thus, Committee observed that the experience, which was the base of the selection of the petitioner was not in order.

4. It is pertinent to mention here that a special relaxation was provided under Rule 7 of Haryana State Education School Cadre, Group B, Service Rule 2012 in HTET to those candidates who have worked as a teacher for a minimum periods of four years, on the date of enforcement of these Rules. The relevant extract of the Rules are given here as under:-

Further, note 1 below Appendix-B says (in case of Direct recruitment the teachers working in Privately managed Govt. Aided, Recognised and Government Schools, are exempted to acquire qualification of passing HTET as described in column 3 if they have worked as a teacher for a minimum period of 4 years on the date of enforcement of these rules. However, the said exemption is as a one-time measure and the said category of teachers on their appointment shall have to qualify HTET by not later than 1st April, 2015 later on the same has been extend upto 1st April, 2018 otherwise their appointment shall stand terminated automatically without giving any further notice.

5. Consequently a Show Cause Notice vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4) dated 21.06.2014 was served upon the petitioner that why his candidature may not be recommended for cancellation to the appropriate authority in view of the observation of the Committee. The petitioner submitted his reply in response to the show cause notice on 07.07.2014. It was also observed that the experience certificate acquired by the petitioner is not as per the norms prescribed by the department for student strength. Thereafter an opportunity of personal hearing was given to the petitioner. He appeared before the

Additional Chief Secretary Secondary Education on 06.08.2014 and reiterated the same facts, which he has already given in his reply. Thereafter, a Show Cause Notice vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4) dated 22.10.2014 was also served upon to the school concerned to prove the genuineness of the teaching experience certificate issued to the candidate concerned. The School Management did not submit its reply to the said show cause notice.


6. Details of students appeared from said school in the 10+2 examination during 01.04.2008 to 31.03.2012 when teaching experience of the petitioner was issued is given as under:-

As per the students strength during the above period, teaching experience, issued to the petitioner appears to be neither genuine nor justifiable. Thus, he does not deserve appointment on the basis of the above experience certificate.

In view of the position enunciated above, Sh. Rajbir Singh S/o Sh. Har Dewa, whose name was recommended by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula for the post of PGT Sociology, cannot be appointed. Hence, his name is recommended for cancellation of the candidature.

Ordered accordingly.
