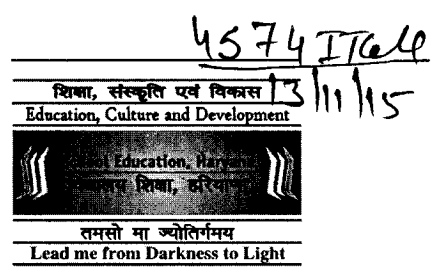

Note :-

1. The official will be relieved immediately and in any case within 3 days failing which he/she will be liable for disciplinary action, However if any official is working in Census duty, he/she shall not be relieved till the Census duty is accomplished.
2. No TA/DA and joining time will be admissible to the official if he/she has been shifted on his/her request after exercising option.
3. No male teacher below the age of 50 years be allowed to join in the girls schools.
4. **If there is no vacancy in the destination school for any reason the incumbent transferred shall re-join his/her previous place of posting and also inform to concerned branch/computer cell at HQ.**
If any discrepancy is noticed in this order or there is a violation of transfer policy, It should be brought to the notice of Computer Cell/Concerned branch within three days and the order be not implemented.
5. In case of mutual transfer, it is directed that before relieving/joining the officials concerned, it may be ensured that the distance between both the schools is not less than 8 km.
6. In case of urban area stations while implementing the transfer orders, it may be ensured that the transferee has completed the rural service as per transfer policy.
7. **The mutual transfer would be effective only when both the employees seeking mutual transfer submit a consent document to their respective Principals.**

Order No. 13/409-2014 HRL (4) Dated, Panchkula the - 10/11/15

Whereas Smt. Rani Devi & another had filed CWP No. 19949 of 2014 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein to issue appointment to her as PGT Mathematics in the Department of School Education Haryana, alongwith pay and allowances w.e.f. 14.12.2013 the date from which, other similar persons have been offered appointment. This writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble Court on 17.09.2014 and Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the following order. The operative part of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court is reproduced here for ready reference:-

".....without going into the correctness of the averments made in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation(s) to the respondent authorities/ competent authority as regards their grievance. In the eventuality of any such representation(s) being preferred, respondent No. 2 would be obligated to consider the same and to take a final decision thereupon within a period of two months from the date of submission of such representation(s).

Petition disposed of."

The brief facts of the case are that the Haryana School Teacher's Selection Board advertised the posts in different subjects of PGT on 07.06.2012 and the name of the petitioner Smt. Rani Devi D/o Sh. Ishwar Singh was recommended for appointment as Post Graduate Teacher in Mathematics, vide Merit No. 799 by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula vide letter No. 2/1/2013-HSTSB/CA dated 02.05.2013. While recommending the name of selected candidates the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula, made the following observation:-

"The selected candidate has not been medically examined and no special enquiry into his/her antecedents has been made. The documents pertaining to his/her qualifications, 4 Year Experience, age, caste/category and Universities as claimed by him/her in the application form may please be got checked/ verified from the issuing authorities, before he/she is allowed to

join her duty. A copy of the appointment letter issued to the candidate may also be endorsed to the Board.”

In view of the above observation of the Haryana Teacher Selection Board, different committees to verify the experience certificate and other documents of the selected candidates were constituted. During verification of experience certificate of the petitioner the committee found that Attendance register and A-Roll of the school seems suspected. No student strength is shown in the official record. Moreover, all record seems prepared fresh. No students strength regarding the appearance in 10+2 exam in different years available from the Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani. Thus, Committee observed that the experience, which was the base of the selection of the petitioner was not in order.

It is pertinent to mention here that a special relaxation was provided under Rule 7 of Haryana State Education School Cadre, Group B, Service Rule 2012 in HTET to those candidates who have worked as a teacher for a minimum period of four years on the date of enforcement of these Rules. The relevant extract of the Rules are given here as under:-

Further, note 1 below Appendix-B says (in case of Direct recruitment the teachers working in Privately managed Govt. Aided, Recognised and Government Schools, are exempted to acquire qualification of passing HTET as described in column 3 if they have worked as a teacher for a minimum period of 4 years on the date of enforcement of these rules. However, the said exemption is as a one-time measure and the said category of teachers on their appointment shall have to qualify HTET by not later than 1st April, 2015 later on the same has been extended upto 1st April, 2018 otherwise their appointment shall stand terminated automatically without giving any further notice.

Consequently, a Show Cause Notices vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4) dated 21.06.2014 was served upon the petitioner that why her candidature may not be recommended for cancellation to the appropriate authority in view of the observation of the Committee. The petitioner submitted her reply in response to the show cause notice dated 01.07.2014. Thereafter, an opportunity of personal hearing was also given to the petitioner. She appeared before the Additional Chief Secretary Secondary Education on 26.07.2014 and reiterated the same facts, which she had already given in her reply. A Show Cause Notice vide memo No. 6/4-2013

HRL (4) dated 22.10.2014 was also served upon to the School/Institution concerned to prove the genuineness of the teaching experience certificate issued to the candidate concerned. The School Management submitted its reply of the said show cause notice on 27.11.2014, which was duly considered by the competent authority.


The details of students appeared from said school in the 10+2 examination during 05.04.2005 to 25.04.2008 and 05.05.2010 to 30.04.2012 when teaching experience of the petitioner was issued is given as under:-

As per the students strength during the above period, teaching experience, issued to the petitioner appears to be neither genuine nor justifiable. Thus, he does not deserve appointment on the basis of the above experience certificate.

In view of the position enunciated above, Smt. Rani Devi D/o Sh. Ishwar Singh, whose name was recommended by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula for the post of PGT Mathematics, cannot be appointed. Hence, her name is hereby recommended for cancellation of her candidature.

Ordered accordingly.

Whereas Sh. Vikram Singh had filed CWP No. 13226 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein to consider his claim for appointment to the post of PGT History (Category No. 17) as the marks secured by petitioner are within cut of marks/merit under General Category and posts of PGT History in the general category are still lying vacant. The Hon'ble High Court disposed of the above said writ petition on 06.07.2015 with the following directions:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner applied for the said post against the general category and he appeared for the written test as well as for the interview. A list of cut off marks of all the candidates was displayed on the website of the respondent-department and the same was even downloaded by the petitioner. The cut-off marks for PGT History (Category No.17) under General Category has been shown as 53.81 but in the merit list, the name of the petitioner has not been shown, whereas, the cut off marks of the last candidate, who was selected, was also the same as that of the present petitioner i.e 53.81. The petitioner made a representation and ultimately, he served a legal notice dated 27.11.2014 (wrongly mentioned in the petition as 27.01.2014) upon the respondent but no action has been taken thereupon so far. Learned counsel further submits that neither any reason has been conveyed to the petitioner nor any order has been passed on the legal notice. Learned counsel also submits that even no waiting list has been prepared and the petitioner is not aware as to whether the names of certain persons, like the petitioner, have been mentioned in the waiting list or not. Such list has not been put on the website or displayed on the notice board. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to the respondent to decide the legal notice within some stipulated period.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the legal notice dated 27.11.2014 and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law.


The necessary speaking order be passed within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

That in compliance of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Court, the legal notice of the petitioner dated 27.11.2014 (Annexure P-8) has been considered. In the legal notice, the petitioner is claiming appointment as PGT in History against 275 posts of PGT History out of which 171 posts were meant for general category, advertised by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula vide advertisement no. 1/2012 dated 07.06.2012 under **Haryana State Education (School Cadre, Group 'B') Service Rules, 2012.**

It is necessary to mention here that the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula who advertised the post of PGT was competent to take decision regarding the selection of the petitioner being designated authority as per instructions. However, after repealing of the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula, the proceedings pending before the Board, before such repeal shall stand transferred to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula by the Government vide notification dated 03.12.2014. Since the whole selection process was carried out by the said selection agency, hence decision regarding the claim of the petitioner at present is required to be taken by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula.

In view of the facts mentioned above, it is suggested that petitioner should approach the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula for redressal of his grievance. A copy of this order is being sent to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula for necessary action.

I order accordingly.
