**ORDER No. 13/30-2015 HRL (4)      DATED, PANCHKULA, THE -21/09/15**

Whereas Sh. Jasbir Singh had filed CWP No.1897 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein to quash the show cause notice dated 21.06.2014 (Annexure P-8) and allow him to join as PGT Punjabi w.e.f. 14.12.2013 being duly selected and appointed in consonance with the provision of the Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India with all consequential benefits such as arrears of pay and seniority w.e.f. 14.12.2013 along with interest @ 12% per annum. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Court on 06.02.2015 with the following directions:-

***".....Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a final decision on the show cause notice issued to the petitioner, to which he has already filed reply, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order."***

The brief facts of the case are that The Haryana School Teacher's Selection Board advertised the posts in different subjects of PGT on 07.06.2012 and the name of the petitioner Sh. Jasbir Singh S/o Sh. Gurcharan Singh was recommended for appointment as Post Graduate Teacher in Punjabi, Merit No. 405 by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula vide letter No. 2/1/2013-HSTSB/2013/CA dated 29.04.2013. While recommending the names of selected candidates the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula had made the following observation:-

***"The selected candidate has not been medically examined and no special enquiry into his/her antecedents has been made. The documents pertaining to his/her qualifications, 4 Year Experience, age, caste/category and Universities as claimed by him/her in the application form may please be got checked/ verified from the issuing authorities, before he/she is allowed to join her duty. A copy of the appointment letter issued to the candidate may also be endorsed to the Board."***

In view of the above observation of the Haryana Teacher Selection Board, different committees to verify the experience certificate and other documents of the selected candidates were constituted. During verification of

experience certificate of the petitioner (i.e. Sh. Jasbir Singh), the committee found that in the record of Guru Hari Krishan Sr. Sec. School, Village Raitkhana (Karnal), there is no name of Principal in Attendance Register but his stamp and sign in the register has shown every month. A-Roll though available but Seems prepared afresh. Thus, Committee observed that the experience, which was the base of the selection of the petitioner was not in order.

It is pertinent to mention here that a special relaxation was provided under Rule 7 of Haryana State Education School Cadre, Group B, Service Rule 2012 in HTET to those candidates who have worked as a teacher for a minimum periods of four years on the date of enforcement of these Rules. The relevant extract of the Rules are given here as under:-

**Further, note 1 below Appendix-B says (in case of Direct recruitment the teachers working in Privately managed Govt. Aided, Recognised and Government Schools, are exempted to acquire qualification of passing HTET as described in column 3 if they have worked as a teacher for a minimum period of 4 years on the date of enforcement of these rules. However, the said exemption is as a one-time measure and the said category of teachers on their appointment shall have to qualify HTET by not later than 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 later on the same has been extend upto 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018 otherwise their appointment shall stand terminated automatically without giving any further notice.**

Consequently a Show Cause Notice vide memo No. 6/4-2013 HRL (4) dated 21.06.2014 was served upon him that why his candidature may not be recommended for cancellation to the appropriate authority in view of the observation of the committee. It was also observed that the experience certificate acquired by the petitioner is not as per the norms prescribed by the department for student strength. The petitioner submitted his reply in response to the show cause notice on 07.07.2014. Thereafter an opportunity of personal hearing was given to the petitioner. He appeared before the Additional Chief Secretary Secondary Education on 26.07.2014 and reiterated the same facts as he has already given in his reply. He was again called to submit any proof to ascertain that he had worked in the school as Lecturer in Punjabi on 07.04.2015 but this time again he submit nothing in writing in support of his claim that he had taught in Guru Hari Krishan Sr. Sec. School, Village Raitkhana (Karnal).

The School Management of Guru Hari Krishan Sr. Sec. School, Village Raitkhana (Karnal) had issued teaching experiences to Sh. Jasbir Singh, PGT Punjabi, Merit No.405, Smt. Saravjit Kaur, Merit No. 270, Smt. Paramdeep Kaur Merit No. 323 and Smt. Varinder Kaur Merit No. 90 respectively, but the teaching experience of all the four candidates relate to almost same period. Details of the students appeared from said school in 10+2 examination during the tenure i.e. 01.11.2006 to 31.08.2009 and 01.08.2010 to till 13.08.2012 given as under:-

As per norms prescribed by the department each section shall be of 50 students and 2<sup>nd</sup> section will be allowed after 50 students and 3<sup>rd</sup> section will be created after 100 students and so on.

The PGT will be given a maximum of 6 periods in a day i.e. total of 36 periods per week, 2<sup>nd</sup> post can also be created after 40 periods.

Thus as per the student strength during the period and on the basis of work load teaching experiences issued by the management to four Lecturers neither genuine nor justifiable.

In compliance of the Hon'ble Court direction dated 06.02.2015, one more opportunity of personal hearing was granted to the petitioner on 30.07.2015 but again he could not produced any new facts or documents in his favour.

In view of the position enunciated above, Sh. Jasbir Singh S/o Sh. Gurcharan Singh, provisionally recommended to the post of PGT Punjabi, cannot be appointed to the post recommended.

Ordered accordingly.





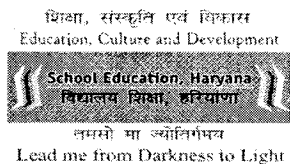

- If there is no vacancy in the destination school for any reason the incumbent transferred shall re-join his/her previous place of posting and also inform to concerned branch/computer cell at HQ.**  
If any discrepancy is noticed in this order or there is a violation of transfer policy, It should be brought to the notice of Computer Cell/Concerned branch within three days and the order be not implemented.
- In case of mutual transfer, it is directed that before relieving/joining the officials concerned, it may be ensured that the distance between both the schools is not less than 8 km.
- In case of urban area stations while implementing the transfer orders, it may be ensured that the transferee has completed the rural service as per transfer policy.
