





ORDER NO.6/8-2016 HRG-II(4) DATED, PANCHKULA, THE 31.3.2016

Whereas, the petitioners filed civil writ petition No. 8084 of 2001, titled as Jai Dayal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others in the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. The said writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.02.2002 and the same was allowed in the terms of CWP No. 17301 of 2000, titled as Swarn Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others. The relevant extract of the order of CWP No. 17301 of 2000 is reproduced here as under:-

"The facts in the present case as already noticed are hardly in dispute. The petitioners were actually promoted and granted one increment as the Head Teachers post carry higher responsibility. The benefit granted to them could not be withdrawn to their disadvantage because the pay scale were revised. The increment was attached to the performance of the function of the higher post with higher responsibility and could not be withdrawn just because there was revision of pay scales. The impugned order passed by the respondents is based upon wrong assumption of law. The concerned authority ought to have taken into consideration the relevant factors and decided the matter in the light of the judgement of the Hon'ble Apex Court and different Division Benches of this Court as referred to above. We find the view taken by the authorities is not in consonance with the principles of law enunciated by this Court in the above judgements. Resultantly, Annexure P-5 is quashed. The respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner in the light of the above law and grant relief to the petitioner in accordance with Rules. The writ petition is accordingly allowed. The parties, however, are left to bear their own costs."

Thereafter, the State of Haryana challenged the order dated 21.02.2002 by filing SLP No. 15182 of 2003, titled as State of Haryana vs. Swaran Singh and others, which was dismissed on 19.03.2010. In this regard, the department also submitted all the relevant papers to Advocate on record on 27.12.2002 for filing the SLP in the present matter. It is worthwhile to mention here that the masters filed another writ petition for taking grade of 6500-10500 to 7500-12000 by filing CWP No. 8082/01 title as R.K. Verma and others, which was decided in favour of the petitioners on 01.12.2010. Aggrieved from the order, the State of Haryana filed LPA No. 951-52/12 and the same

was dismissed vide order dated 31.10.2012. Further the State of Haryana filed SLP No. 19054-55 of 2013 which was dismissed on 01.11.2013. Thereafter, R.A. No. 2661-62/2014 was also filed, but the same was also dismissed on 02.12.2014. After that on examination, the Finance Department issued instruction dated 16.03.2015 to grant the pay scale of Rs. 7500-12500 instead of 6500-10500 to the Headmasters. In view of the same, the department issued instructions dated 25.03.2015 to all the District Education Officers in the state for compliance of aforesaid instructions of the Finance Department.

That Further in compliance of the aforesaid order of the Hon'ble Court, the matter has been examined by the respondents and it has been found that the petitioners were serving as 'Master' from 01.01.1996 in the pay scale of Rs. 5500-175-9000. The petitioners were granted benefits of Assured Career Progression pay scales i.e. Rs. 6500-200-9900 or 6500-200- 10500 with effect from 01-01-1996 under the provisions of Haryana Civil Services (ACP) Pay Rules, 1998, thereafter, they have been promoted as Headmaster of High School in the pay scale of Rs. 6500-200-10500. Further the pay scale of the Headmaster of High School was modified by the Finance Department vide U.O. No. 6/76-2010-4PR(FD) dated 16.03.2015 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 from 6500 -10500 to 7500-12000 and vide order No. 6/101-2013 HRG-II(2) dated 25.03.2015, all the District Education Officers were directed to grant this benefit to the petitioners/Headmasters. Since, the petitioners were already granted benefits of pay scales of higher post in the form of ACP pay scales, therefore, the petitioners are not entitled to get another additional increment on being promoted on promotional post as Head master of High School to double the benefit. While serving as Headmaster of High School in the pay scale of Rs. 6500-200-9900 or 6500-200-10500, the petitioners were further promoted as Headmaster of High School in the identical pay scales but vide this office order No.6/101-2013 HRG-II(2) Dated 25.03.2015, all the Headmasters serving in the State of Haryana were granted pay scale of Rs. 7500-250-12000 with effect from 01-01-1996. In view of this, the pay of the petitioners has been re-fixed and the re-fixation of pay of the petitioners in the pay scale of Rs. 7500-250-12000 is given here as under:


