ORDER NO. 13/5-2015 HRL (3)

DATED, PANCHKULA, THE 7-1-2016

Whereas civil writ petition No. 459 of 2015 was filed by the twenty petitioners for quashing the seniority list of Lecturer (School Cadre) as on 01.10.2011 finalized and circulated by the respondent no. 2 on 07.11.2014 without following the principal of natural justice, whereby the petitioners have been made junior to the persons who were shown below to the petitioners in the provisional seniority list and also prayed to reconstruct the seniority list taking into consideration, the date of entry into the service of the petitioners and merit list of selection of the lecturer after adopting the Principle of natural justice. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on 21.05.2015 with the following directions:-

“In case the petitioners/private respondents/effected persons file the objections to the tentative seniority list, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents passing a detailed and reasoned order in accordance with law. In essence, petitioners shall be given opportunity of hearing.

Till the seniority list is finalized, in order to avoid the complicity and anomalous situation, much less, discrimination, the State shall not take any action in pursuance to the impugned seniority list;

It is expected that the State shall undertake the exercise of considering the directions within a reasonable time, preferably within a period of three months.

In view of directions reproduced hereinabove, the present petition also stands disposed of with the above said directions. However, the petitioners are directed to file objections within a period of one month, which shall be decided by the respondents within a period of three months thereafter.”

That in response to the above directions of the Hon'ble Court, the representation of the petitioners dated 12.06.2015, which was received in the office of the Director Secondary Education Haryana on 16.06.2015 was considered and after taking cognizance thereon, they were also heard in person

on 17.12.2015. In their representation dated 12.06.2015, they mainly contended that the seniority list of Lecturer (School Cadre) as on 01.10.2011 and also circulated on 01.10.2011 was correct and subsequent rectification made by the Department is not in order and they have not given opportunity before rectifying the same. From the official record, it has been found that besides the representation of the petitioners more than 150 representations of others lecturers are also pending in the Department for taking decision and which are being considered as per Haryana School Education Rules, These rules are called the Haryana State Education School Cadre Short title, (Group B) Service Rules, 2012. Thus the claim of the petitioners will also be finalized alongwith other candidates. Accordingly, the grievance of petitioners have been considered and if found permissible as per rule/regulations of Government, action will be taken accordingly.

I pass on order accordingly.

Whereas civil writ petition No. 692 of 2015 was filed by the eight petitioners for quashing the seniority list of Lecturer (School Cadre) as on 01.10.2011 finalized and circulated by the respondent no. 2 on 07.11.2014 without following the principal of natural justice, whereby the petitioners have been made junior to the persons who were shown below to the petitioners in the provisional seniority list and also prayed to reconstruct the seniority list taking into consideration, the date of entry into the service of the petitioners and merit list of selection of the lecturer after adopting the Principle of natural justice. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on 08.04.2015 with the following directions:-

“In case the petitioners/private respondents/effected persons file the objections to the tentative seniority list, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents passing a detailed and reasoned order in accordance with law. In essence, petitioners shall be given opportunity of hearing.

Till the seniority list is finalized, in order to avoid the complicity and anomalous situation, much less, discrimination, the State shall not take any action in pursuance to the impugned seniority list;

It is expected that the State shall undertake the exercise of considering the directions within a reasonable time, preferably within a period of three months.”

That in response to the above directions of the Hon'ble Court, the representation of the petitioners dated 08.05.2015, which was received in the office of the Director Secondary Education Haryana on 26.05.2015 was considered and after taking cognizance thereon, they were also heard in person on 23.12.2015. In their representation dated 08.05.2015, they mainly contended that the seniority list of Lecturer (School Cadre) as on 01.10.2011 and also circulated on 01.10.2011 was correct and subsequent rectification made by the Department is not in order and they have not given opportunity before rectifying the same. From the official record, it has been found that

besides the representation of the petitioners more than 150 representations of others lecturers are also pending in the Department for taking decision and which are being considered as per Haryana School Education Rules. These rules are called the Haryana State Education School Cadre Short title, (Group B) Service Rules, 2012. Thus the claim of the petitioners will also be finalized alongwith other candidates. Accordingly, the grievance of petitioners have been considered and if found permissible as per rule/regulations of Government, action will be taken accordingly.
