

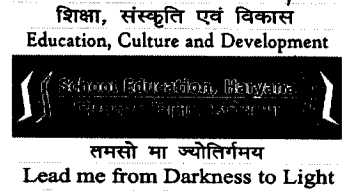

Whereas Sh Brijesh Kumar and others filed Civil Writ Petition No. 22875 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, which was disposed of vide order dated 28-10-15. The relevant para is reproduced as under:-

"Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 2 to expeditiously decide representation dated 11.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order."

That in compliance of the above order the representation/legal notice dated 11-11-2014 of the petitioners has been examined by the office. The petitioners submitted that they were entitled for one additional increment of higher responsibility as per Rule 4.4 of CSR Volume 1 part 1 read with rule 4.13 of CSR Volume 1 part 1 and on the basis of order passed in various writ petitions by the Hon'ble High Court.

As per provisions in Note below Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 15 of the Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 1998 the placement in the first or second ACP Scale does not amount to a functional promotion and, therefore, the presumption of higher responsibility cannot be taken in such placements in the ACP Scale. However, the benefit of fixation of pay corresponding to the placement in the higher pay scale as a consequence of promotion that is presumption of higher responsibility shall be extended at the stage of fixation of pay in the first or second ACP Scale. If the functional pay scale of the promotional post and the ACP Pay Scale drawn by the servant prior to the promotion are identical, his pay will not be fixed in the functional pay scale of promotional post and he will continue to draw the salary at the same stage and his date of increment will also continue to remain the same as before the promotion para-8 of the Memo dated 02.03.2001 issued by the Department of Finance, wherein it is mentioned under Clause (iii) that if an employee is in receipt of first and second ACP scale as a personal measure and then gets promoted and the functional pay scale of the promotional post is equal to or lower than the scale in which he is already drawing his pay as a measure personal to him, his pay will not be re-fixed and will remain at the same stage in the same scale in which he was drawing his pay at the time of his promotion. Supreme Court has also decided the same issue in the case of State of Haryana



and another vs. Partap Singh and others, (2006) 10 SCC 251 as also the Division Bench judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 3790 of 2006 titled as Smt. Neelam Bali and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 06.03.2009 and the judgments passed by the Supreme Court in Partap Singh's case (supra) and Union of India vs. Ashok Kumar Banerjee, 1998 (3) RSJ 105.

Finance Department further clarified vide No. 2/102/2009-2PR(FD), dated 9th April, 2010 that as per existing provisions, contained in note below Rule 18 of HCS (ACP) Rules, 2008, if the grade pay of promotional post and ACP pay structure in which the Government servant is drawing his pay prior to promotion are identical, his pay will not again be fixed in the functional pay structure of the promotional post which is identical to the ACP Pay structure in which he was drawing his pay before promotion. He will continue to draw his salary at the same stage and his date of increment will also continue to be same as before promotion.

Further provision of Rule 27 and 28 of HCS (ACP) Rules, 2008 that the grade pay of the promotional post is higher than that of ACP pay structure in which the Government employee is drawing his salary prior to promotion, his pay will not be re-fixed and he will only get the difference of grade pay and his date of next increment will continue to be same as before promotion and it will not be treated Financial Up gradation under HCS (ACP) Rules, 2008.

Provided that above methodology will not be applicable in the cases where grade pay of ACP pay structure granted under rule 13 of HCS (ACP) Rules, 2008 is higher than that of the grade pay of the promotional post in which, the Government employee is drawing his salary prior to ACP structure, his pay will be raised by 3% of the total pay in the pay band and grade pay drawn before such ACP up gradation and grade pay of the relevant ACP pay structure will be in addition.

If the grade pay of the promotional post is inferior than that of ACP pay structure in which the Government employee is drawing his salary prior to the promotion, his pay will not be re-fixed and he will continue to draw his salary at the same stage and his date of increment will also continue to be same as before promotion.

After perusal of the facts it is clear that as per the ACP Rules, 1998, once an employee on a feeder post has reached the stage of the functional pay scale of the promotional post on the basis of grant of ACP scale, he is not entitled to refixation of his pay in the functional pay scale of the promotional post, which is identical to the ACP Scale drawn by the said employee. He will continue to draw the salary at the same stage and his date of increment will also continue to be the same as before his promotion.





It is further clarified that Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh recently decided this issue as common questions of law and facts are involved vide judgement dated 17-8-2015 passed in CWP No. 22066 of 2012 and dismissed the writ petitions including 33 CWPs [Nos 21846 of 2011, 12657, 23231, 22204, 20079, 22066, 22185, 22186, 22210, 22325, 22431, 22518, 22610, 22622, 23505, 18026, 18053, 15785 and 24048 of 2012; 2831, 4534, 7958 and 8448 of 2013; 6316, 11593 and 6913 of 2014; 14960 of 2005; 8543 and 14284 of 2001; 16999 of 2006; 12602 of 2001; 6444 of 2005 and 2991 of 2006 (O&M)].

The petitioners are drawing 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> ACP as Master or Language Teachers i.e. Rs. 9300-34800+4800 and Rs. 9300-34800+5400 and thereafter promoted as Headmasters in the pay scale of Rs 9300-34800+5400. Therefore, in view of the submissions made above and the court orders, the petitioners are not entitled for one additional increment as Higher Responsibility on the grounds explained above. Hence the claim of the petitioners is here-by rejected.

I order accordingly.



Whereas Sh. Narender Kumar and another have filed a civil writ petition no. 15244 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and prayed therein to quash the action of the respondents not to fill up the posts of PGT Physics as per 50 % quota of promotion though the petitioners and many others are eligible to be promoted as PGT Physics as per Haryana State Education Lecturer (School Cadre) (Group C) Rules, 1998. This writ petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble High Punjab and Haryana High Court on 29.07.2015 with the following directions:-

**"Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection, the petitioners have got issued a legal notice (Annexure P-2) and that they would be satisfied if at this stage a direction is issued to respondent no. 1 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order within any reasonable time.**

**I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 to decide the legal notice of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order thereon within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy thereof. "**

That in view of the above directions of the Hon'ble Court, the legal notice of the petitioners (Annexure P-II) has been considered, wherein they are claiming promotion on the basis of Haryana State Education Lecturer (School Cadre) (Group C) Rules, 1998, but at present, the services of the Lecturers is governed under Haryana State Education Lecturer (School Cadre) (Group B) Rules, 2012, wherein the promotion quota for the post of PGT is prescribed as 33 %. Moreover, under the New Rules, qualification prescribed for the post of PGT is altogether different from the Rules, 1998. Under the new Rules, one must have two years teaching experience as TGT in the same subject. The qualification prescribed under the Rules 2012 is laid down as under:-

- I. M.Sc. Physics / Applied Physics / Nuclear Physics / Electronics Physics with at least 50 % marks and B.Ed. from recognized university, AND**
- II. 2 years teaching experience as TGT Science ; AND**
- III. Certificate of having qualified Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET)/School Teacher Eligibility Test (STET).**

Both the petitioners are claiming promotion as Lecturer in Physics, on the basis of their qualification M.Sc. in Physics, whereas their initial recruitment was as Maths Masters, thus as TGT, they have teaching experience in their credit only as Maths Master, whereas as per requirement of the Rules, 2012, they should have to possess two years teaching experience as TGT

Science. Thus, their case for promotion could not be considered on the basis of their above qualification.


That further contention of the petitioners is that their cases for promotion should be considered under the old rules, but this question has been settled by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Deepak Aggarwal Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported in (2011) 6 SCC 725, wherein the observation of the Hon'ble Court is as under:-

**"Deepak Aggarwal & another Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh & others reported in (2011) 6 SCC 725, held that it is by now a settled proposition of law that a candidate has the right to be considered in the light of existing rules, which implies the "rule in force" on the date the consideration took place. There is no rule of universal or absolute application that vacancies are to be filled invariably by the law existing on the date when the vacancy arises."**

It is clear from the above observations of the Hon'ble Court that claim of the petitioner is also liable to be rejected on this ground that their cases for promotion should be considered in accordance with the old Rules.

In view of the position explained above, the cases of the petitioners are not covered under the new Rules since they have not requisite qualifications in their credit. So, the claims of the petitioners are rejected being devoid of merits.

I pass an order accordingly.




